SCHOOL FEE

The method of remitting fees to the school is through an Electronics Transaction (RTGS, NEFT, IMPS)/Cash/Cheque. The school does not accept any other mode of payment, except under certain circumstances that are explained later in this section.

- It is mandatory to pay the fee quarterly by the 15th day of the first month of each quarter.
- Annual charges are payable every year by the month of April
- If the cheque is bounced by the bank for any reason it will be treated as non payment and
 in lieu of that only Cash/NEFT/IMPS/RTGS will be accepted with the penalty (cheque
 bounce) plus late fee fine till the date of re-payment of the same
- If a parent omits or fails to pay the fee of his/her child due to the school with fine by
 the last working day of the month in which it is due, name of his/her child shall
 be struck off from the rolls of the school on the first working day of the following
 month and the student shall be re-admitted on the payment of all pending dues,
 fine along with re-admission fees of Rs. 5000/-.

- Parent/guardian must carry their access cards while receiving their words.
- Shouting or misbehaviour with the driver, helper or maid can lead to immediate withdrawal
 of school transport facility.
- Transport facility will be made available on specified routes and designated stops only, at the sole discretion of the school management.
- It is so understand that school transport, like any other vehicle on road, may get delayed sometimes
 due to traffic conditions, road conditions, or some technical fault. The parents should understand
 these practical situations and they should be at their best in cooperating towards the same.
- The school transport routes are subject to change depending upon the requirements of the students and it is at the sole discretion of the school management.
- For any addition or change in the route, the interested parent(s) may contact the Transport Incharge with a written request. The change may be allowed as per feasibility and availability.
- School transport is an optional facility and it cannot be claimed as a matter of right by any student/ parent. The school management reserves the right to withdraw the school transport facility from any student without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- The school transport is arranged by the school for a complete academic session. Thus school transport cannot be withdrawn between the academic sessions.
- In case any parent wishes to withdraw from the school transport facility for the next academic session, he' she is required to inform the school in writing, in advance of the withdrawal otherwise one month's transport fee will be charged in lieu of one month's notice.
- The Transport fee is determined by the distance students travels. Please note that the distance, in kilometres, is measured according to the route taken by the bus, not by the Google Maps.
- · While calculating the bus fee, partial usage during any month will be calculated as the full month.
- The amount is payable along with school fee, on the quarterly basis and for 12 months.
- A written application must be given one month in advance to discontinue the transport facility and the dues for the month of withdrawal shall be paid.

SAFETY MEASURES AT SCHOOL

ACTION DURING EARTHQUAKE

- Do not rush to go out to avoid a stampede.
- Take children, aged and sick out before leaving the building/ room.
- If you are outside stay away from building and utility works.
- Stay in the open till the vibrations stop
- If you are in a moving vehicle, stop as quickly as possible and come out of the vehicle.
- Free all pets and domestic animals so that they can run outside.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- Students shall come to school on time and be nearly dressed in proper school uniform.
- · No student shall leave the class room without permission.
- No moretary collection for any purpose may be made in the school without the prior permission of the Principal.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school campus without the permission of the Principal.

- The Principal has full authority to give transfer certificate to the existing students on disciplinary charges.
- A student must extend due courtesy and respect to all staff members. Respect for elders and
 affection for juniors should be soundly inculcated. Refinement in behaviour should distinguish every
 pupil of the school. Every child is expected to aphold the name and honor of the school. Student
 should be habitually clean and nently dressed.

ABSENCE & WITHDRAWAL

- Students are responsible for making up all work missed during period of their obsence.
- No student will avail a planned leave without prior sanction of the class teacher. Leave record in the student dairy has to be filled by the parent, failure of which will call for disciplinary problems.
- Withdrawal/Transfer should be applied by the student before 31"January of the academic session attended.
- For withdrawing a child from the school, parent has to give an application form for issuing
- Transfer or school leaving certificate and progress card will not be issued until all dues are paid.
- One clear calendar months' notice through e-mail or a month's fee in lieu of such notice must be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.

LEAVE / ABSENCE

As regular attendance is an important element of education, no leave or absence will be granted except on medical grounds.

ADVISORY FOR PARENTS

Home study and parental co-operation

PARENTS – TEACHERS INTERACTIONS


